4. Examination Policy: During examinations, you must do your own work. Talking or discussion is not permitted during the examinations, nor may you compare papers, copy from others, or

collaborate in any way. Any collaborative behavior during the examinations will result in failure of the exam and may lead to failure of the course and University disciplinary action.

5. Consequences: Any student who is suspected of cheating or copying or plagiarizing another person's work for an examination, a paper, or any other assignment will automatically receive an F for the assignment and undergo an investigation by a review board. The review board, consisting of the Academic Dean and two other appointed faculty members, will review the evidence and circumstances of cheating or plagiarism. Upon confirmation of the incident, the Board will recommend consequences to the President-Rector and formation advisor faculty at its next meeting, which may include formation probation, failure of the assignment, failure of the course, dismissal from the seminary, or a combination of the above. Students who are caught cheating or plagiarizing more than once will be subject to dismissal from the seminary program. Students who knowingly allow their work to be used in such a manner will be liable to an equal penalty.
