Dear Friends in Christ,

The Lord’s blessings upon St. Patrick’s are evident in the quality of professors and formators we continue to recruit. As I announced in my previous letter, the Marians of the Immaculate Conception, based at the Divine Mercy Shrine in Stockbridge, MA, are now sending their seminarians to St. Patrick’s; and, as a result, Fr. Jim McCormack, MIC, has joined our faculty. I am happy to inform you that besides Fr. McCormack, the following priests have also joined the seminary faculty this academic year: Rev. Sean Kilcawley of the Diocese of Lincoln, NE, and Rev. Michael Liliedahl of the Archdiocese of San Francisco. We also welcomed Prof. Christopher Berry, a highly regarded organist and choral conductor, and Ms. Leelamma Sebastian, an expert in pastoral formation. In addition to coming on board as Assistant Professor of Sacred Music at the seminary, Prof. Berry is serving as the Director of Music at the Church of the Nativity (the parish up the street from the seminary) as well as the inaugural director of a new chorister program sponsored by our Catholic Institute of Sacred Music. Ms. Sebastian, who comes to us most recently from St. Mary’s Seminary in Baltimore, MD, returns to St. Patrick’s (she worked here in the 2010s) as the head of our Pastoral Studies program.

The signs of the Lord’s fruitful activity are also evident in our various institutes and initiatives. At the end of May, our Institute for Philosophy, Technology, and Politics hosted its second annual seminar in partnership with *First Things* at the seminary. Dr. Rusty Reno, Editor-in-Chief of *First Things*, and our own Dr. Mark Shiffman, director of the Institute, led a substantive day-long seminar on the topic of kingship and authority. The main presenter at this year’s seminar was author Mary Harrington, who delivered a paper entitled “The King

and the Swarm.” Responses were delivered by Dr. Nathan Pinkoski and Dr. Mark Shiffman.

At the end of June, our Initiative for Priestly Renewal, under the direction of Dr. Anthony Lilles, hosted its first *Confessors’ Institute* retreat, a multi-day event that gathered a wide range of priests from across the United States and beyond to reflect on the central importance of the sacrament of penance in the lives of the faithful—including and especially of priests—and the urgent need for a renewed appreciation for this sacrament.

This July we hosted a major liturgical conference at the seminary under the auspices of our Catholic Institute of Sacred Music. As she is wont to do, the director of the Institute, Dr. Jennifer Donelson-Nowicka, once again organized a world-class conference. As we did three summers ago, so again St. Patrick’s hosted prominent prelates, scholars, liturgists, and artists from around the world for what proved to be a grace-filled, four-day conference. In attendance this year were His Eminence Robert Cardinal Sarah, His Eminence Séan Cardinal O’Malley (Archbishop Emeritus of Boston, MA), as well as His Eminence Malcolm Cardinal Ranjith (Archbishop of Colombo, Sri Lanka).

These initiatives are made possible by your generous and consistent support, both spiritual and material. On behalf of the seminarians, faculty, and staff of St. Patrick’s, thank you. Be assured of our continued and constant prayers for you and your intentions.






